
A monthly newsletter filled with news, information and events for all things SEND in the Redcar & Cleveland area.

With that in mind have a lovely Christmas, whatever it looks like, and best wishes for 2024 from the team at SEND Family Voice.



Family Information Service

The Family Information Service is ran by Daisy Chain and offers services to children, young people and families who display traits associated with neurodevelopment diversity: Autism (ASD), Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD) and Foetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorder (FASD).

Services are reviewed to ensure they are meeting the need of families, however providers need feedback from parents and carers. It would be helpful, if as many parents and carers as possible, could complete the survey to provide their feedback. What is working, what is not and what would you like to see. It would also be beneficial to provide feedback if you have not accessed the services and the reasons for this, such as transport barriers for example.

Shortbreaks Event



A drop in event which will have information about shortbreaks and all it has to offer. The club providers, who work together with Shortbreaks, will also be in attendance to explain what they can offer.

Families who do not have a max card can also apply for one the day as well as sign up for the SEND family mailing list. To sign up for your free max card, please bring one of the following to confirm SEND Status:

- Confirmation your child has an EHCP*
- Confirmation you are registered on RCBCs Disability Register*
- Name of your child's Social Worker*
- Any other evidence e.g. DLA award, proof of diagnosis

*If evidence provided is 1, 2, or 3 we will check our systems to verify eligibility.

This is a great opportunity to find out what Shortbrek services are and how they can support children, young people and their families.
