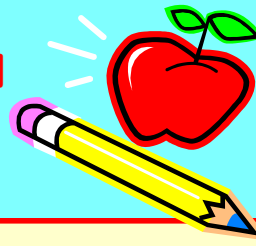


Lockwood Primary School Newsletter
