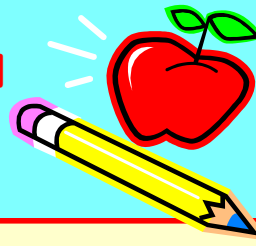


## Lockwood Primary School Newsletter
