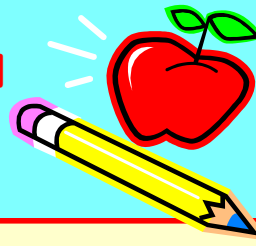

Thank you to all of you that managed to attend our 'Coffee and Cake' event and bought numbers for Easter Egg raffle. It was amazing to see so many of you back in school.

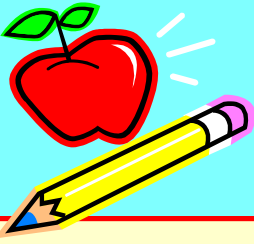

World Earth Day Posters

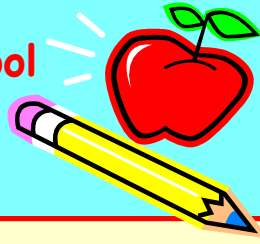
On Monday we celebrated Earth Day in school. Children learned about ways to help look after our planet and each made a 'pledge' to become more environmentally aware.
