### Bike ability

Our lovely Year 5 will be having Bike ability lessons over the next couple of weeks. Every child will access level 1 training and some level 2. Level 2 training is out on the roads and the Local Authority instructors will make the decision as to which children are ready for the level 2 part of the training.

Children not chosen to complete level 2 have not failed - they are just not ready yet to be on the roads and we may be able to give them the opportunity to complete the training in Year 6. The bike ability team have dropped some bicycles and helmets off in school today for those without bikes of their own to use. When children bring in their own bikes on Monday we would ask that they please walk them across the playground to keep all on the playground safe. **Children should wear PE kits all week with suitable footwear.**
