Family Information Service

The Family Information Service is ran by Daisy Chain and offers services to children, young people and families who display traits associated with neurodevelopment diversity: Autism (ASD), Attention Deficit Hyperactivity

Disorder (ADHD) and Foetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorder (FASD).

Services are reviewed to ensure they are meeting the need of families, however providers need feedback from parents and carers. It would be helpful, if as many parents and carers as possible, could complete the survey to provide their feedback. What is working, what is not and what would you like to see. It would also be beneficial to provide feedback if you have not accessed the services and the reasons for this, such as transport barriers for example.

- Confirmation your child has an EHCP*
- Confirmation you are registered on RCBCs Disability Register*
- Name of your child's Social Worker*
- Any other evidence e.g. DLA award, proof of diagnosis

*If evidence provided is 1, 2, or 3 we will check our systems to verify eligibility.

This is a great opportunity to find out what Shortbrek services are and how they can support children, young people and their families.
