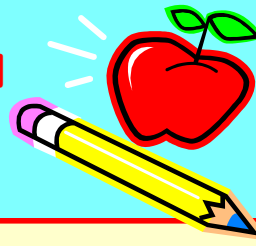


# Lockwood Primary School Newsletter
